

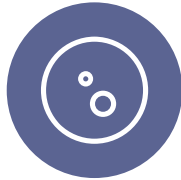

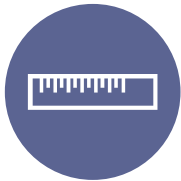

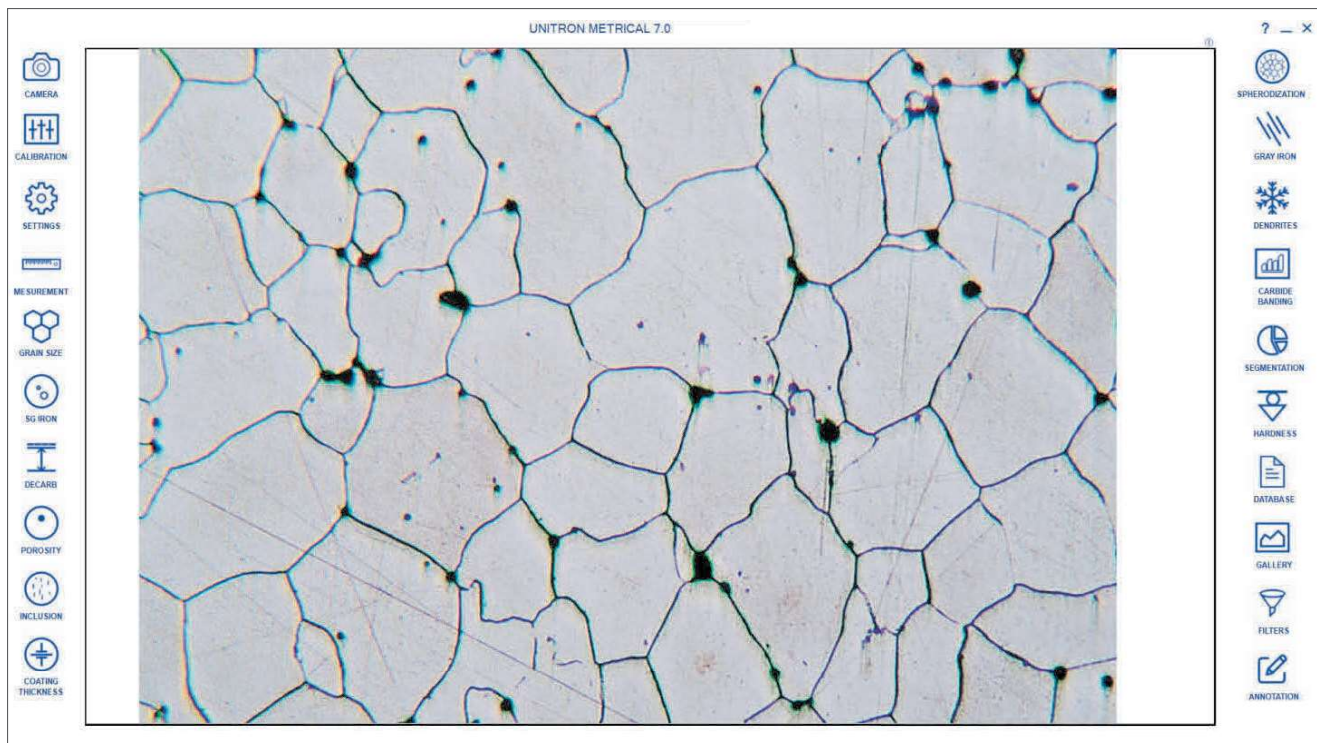

Some of the major modules in Metrical are as follows:

CAMERA

One can select different display/capture sizes along with other setting like white balance, brightness, contrast, Hue, Saturation can be changed on live displayed image. Once all setting are done, image can be captured in appropriate folder for appropriate analysis.

CALIBRATION

Calibration should be performed on all the objectives of the microscope, where Digital Camera is installed. Calibration should be performed only when all hardwares are finally fixed. In case of readjustments or replacement of any part, calibration should be done again.

MEASUREMENT

With the Measurement module one can obtain measurement on manually drawn lines on traces, shapes or by outlining an object Which can be accumulated and logged on to the results worksheet from where they can be stored to a file, printed or transferred to spread sheet for further analysis or statistics.

GRAIN SIZE

This module can quickly perform automatic, objective and repeatable grain size analysis to industrial standards to determine ferritic & austenitic grain size in steel, international method ASTM E-112, E-93, E1181 are used.



GRAIN SIZE

POROSITY

Pores, due to their contrast with the rest of the image, are relatively easy to detect automatically the module allows a user to recognize and measure the porosity in the material according to ASTM B276 Standard Thresholding readily accomplished using gray scale techniques. The dark phase of porosity is detected in red bitplanes.

SEGMENTATION

Segmentation is a method of image partitioning on the intensity / grayscale range of its parts. Since a phase is detected and its area is estimated on the basis of its intensity / grayscale, an option for delineating phases from the histogram is also provided. Multiple phases are identify by colored overlays and can be simultaneously displayed in the same field of view.

SG IRON

CARBIDE

Iron carbide or Cementite is an intermetallic component of iron and Carbon. While iron Carbide as present in most steels and Cast Iron, it is produced as raw material in the iron carbide process, which belongs to the family of alternative iron making technology.

COATING THICKNESS

Plating or coating thickness is determined by cross-sectional microscopy method. The specimen is cross-sectioned, mounted, polished and microscopically evaluated for measuring the plating or coating thickness, sometimes, etching of the core base metal may be necessary to accurately measure the coating or plating thickness. The test method covers measurements of the local thickness of metal and oxide coatings by the microscopical examination of cross sections using an optical microscope.



COATING THICKNESS

SPHERODIZATION

This module is designed to analyze spheroidal graphite (nodules). The nodules are separated from non-nodules on predefined spheroidicity. Nodules acquire blue color and non-nodule get red color. Nodules from (designated by Roman numbers from I to VI) and size (designated by Arabic numbers 1 to 8) are reported along with the calculated nodules/sq mm.

Using Metrical software a user can identify four types of inclusion.

SULFIDE TYPE (A TYPE), ALUMINA TYPE (B TYPE)

SILICATE TYPE (C TYPE), GLOBULAR TYPE (D TYPE)

Each type is further divided into Thin and Heavy, based on the width parameters.

The software includes an Automated Vickers Hardness Test module, which uses a square-based diamond pyramid indenter with a 136.5° angle between opposite faces. It precisely applies force to a test surface, then automatically measures the diagonals of the resulting indentation to calculate hardness values, ensuring quick and accurate material hardness assessment.

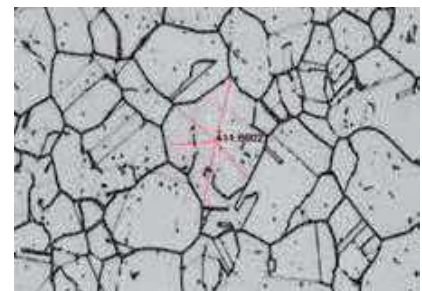
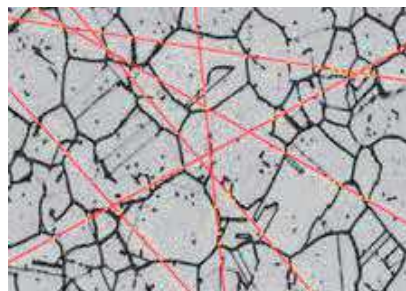
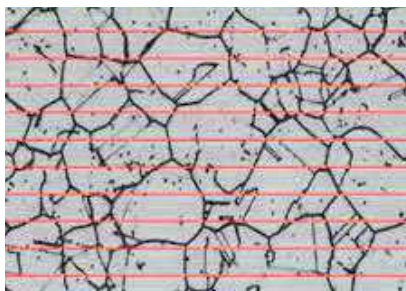
Comprehensive selection of analysis technique are:

Segmentation

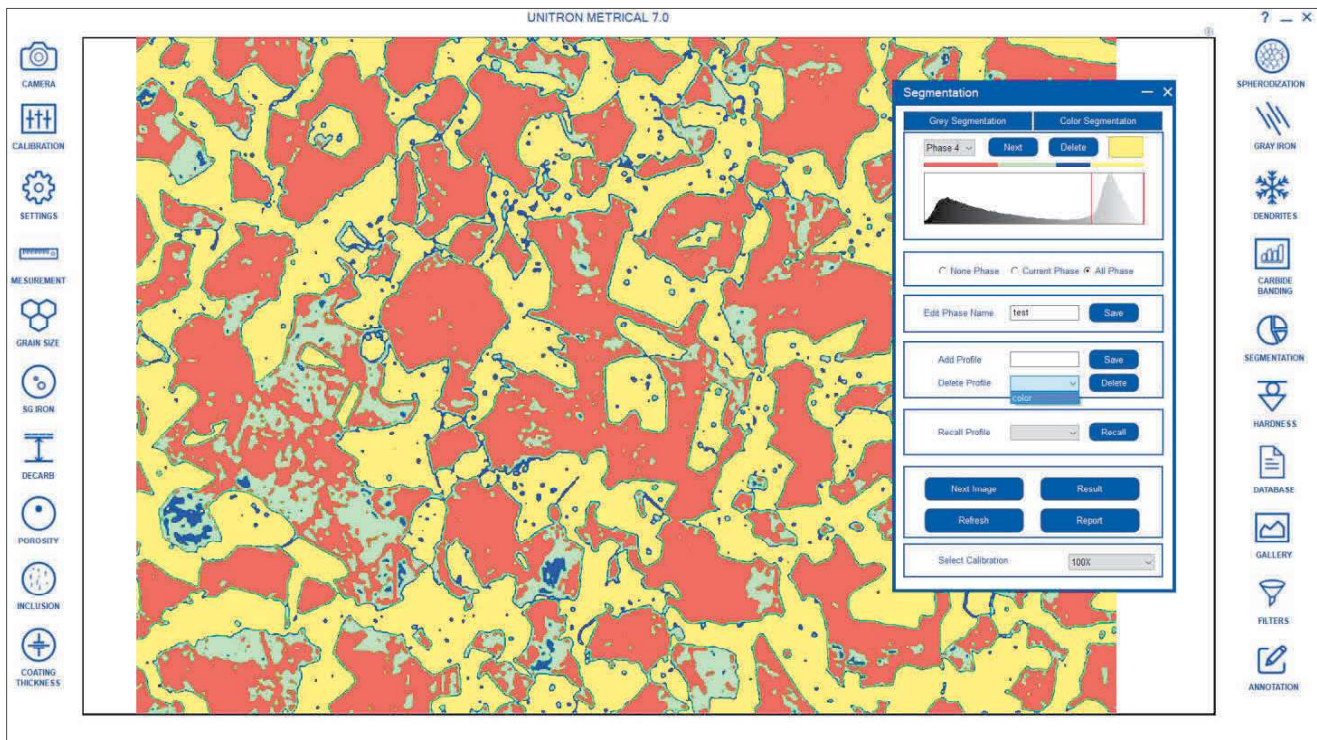
Segmentation is a method of image partitioning on the intensity / grayscale range of its parts. Since a phase is detected and its area is estimated on the basis of its intensity / grayscale, an option for delineating phases from the histogram is also provided. Multiple phases are identify by colored overlays and can be simultaneously displayed in the same field of view. The results and images displayed get stored in to distinguish the phases prominently. Various filters like Despeckle, Smoothing etc can be used before doing the phase.

A histogram for gray scale images is created once you open the Segmentation Module. The X-axis represents intensity scale between 0-255. The Y-axis represents number of pixels in the image. analysis. the industrial standard automatically.

HISTOGRAM: Phase allows the user to designate up to ten different threshold settings to identify material phases and name each of these phases. The color between two lines signifies a particular phase.

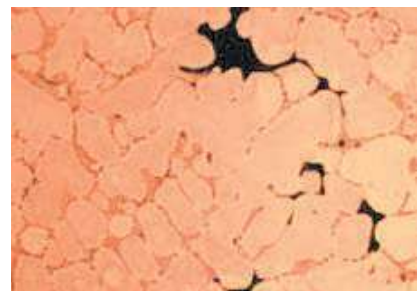
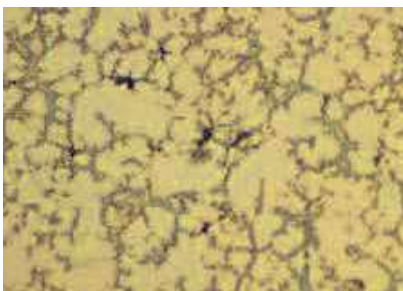
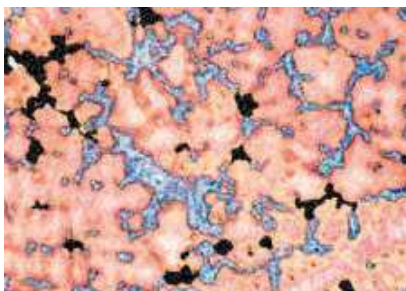
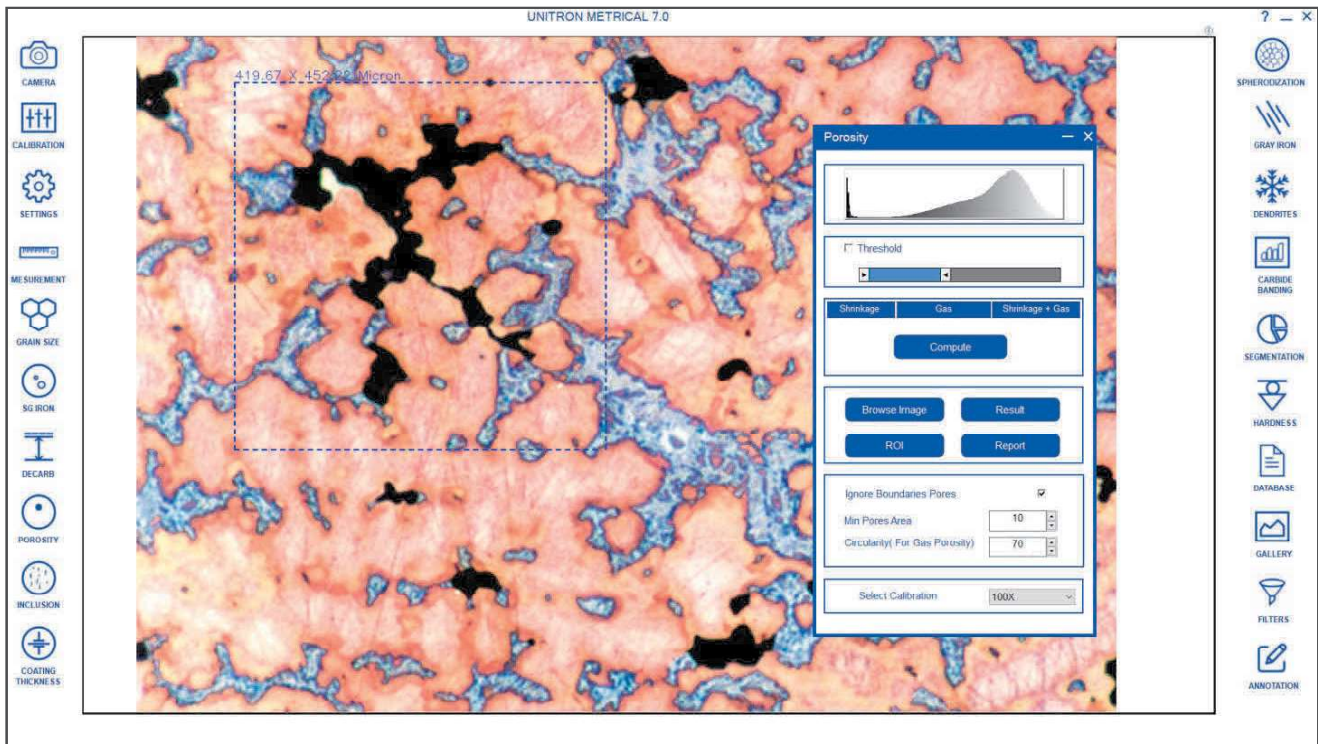
INTENSITY: The Gray Intensity range of the current phase gets display continuously in the dialogue box.

SELECTED PHASE: This property enable the user to know the percentage area of a specific range of intensity just by clicking the mouse. All previous operations have to be deleted and Preview should be on None.



Porosity

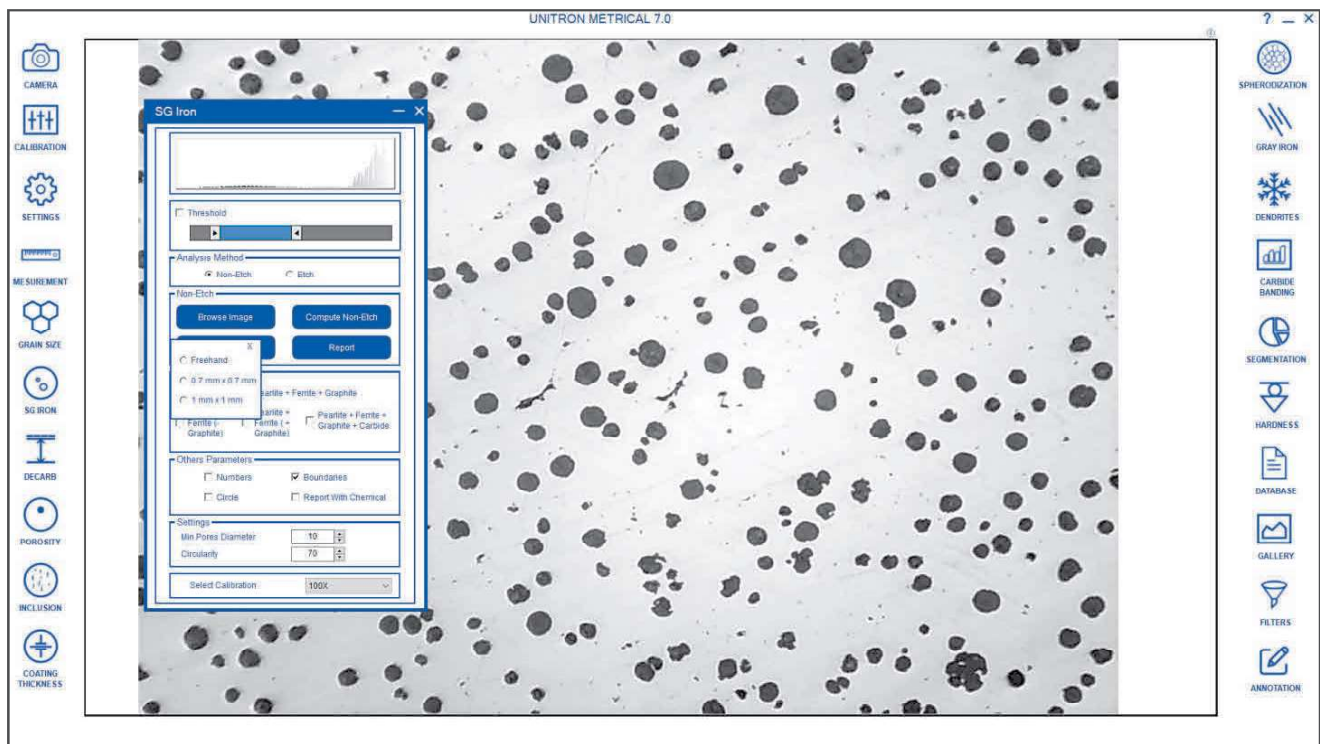
Pores, due to their contrast with the rest of the image, are relatively easy to detect automatically. The module allows a user to recognize and measure the porosity in the material according to ASTM B276 Standard Thresholding readily accomplished using gray scale techniques. The dark phase of porosity is detected in red bitplanes. The total number of pores are counted along with their percentage of minimum & maximum size are also identified and reported. The whole process is fully automatic.

Ductile Iron/Nodularity

Ductile Iron, also known as ductile cast Iron, Nodular Cast Iron, Spheroidal Graphite Iron & SG Iron is a type of Graphite rich cast Iron. We use image processing algorithms like segmentation using Global thresholding, Boundary detection and Artificial Neural Network. Nodules touching boundaries are excluded in analysis. Artifacts less than 10 microns are excluded. Non-nodules are separated from Non-nodules on predefined spherodicity. For analysis of SG Iron, we compute quality parameters such as Nodules counts, Nodule Size (designated by Arabic no. 1 to 8), Nodule form (designated by roman number I to VI). All analysis are done with single button push. In the second step, etched samples are analysed. The software automatically calculates the percentage Graphite, Pearlite once the analysis completed. All data of Non-etched and etched sample is appended into a results spreadsheet directly with in the image analysis software. Reports containing relevant analysis data and associated images are generated with one button push.

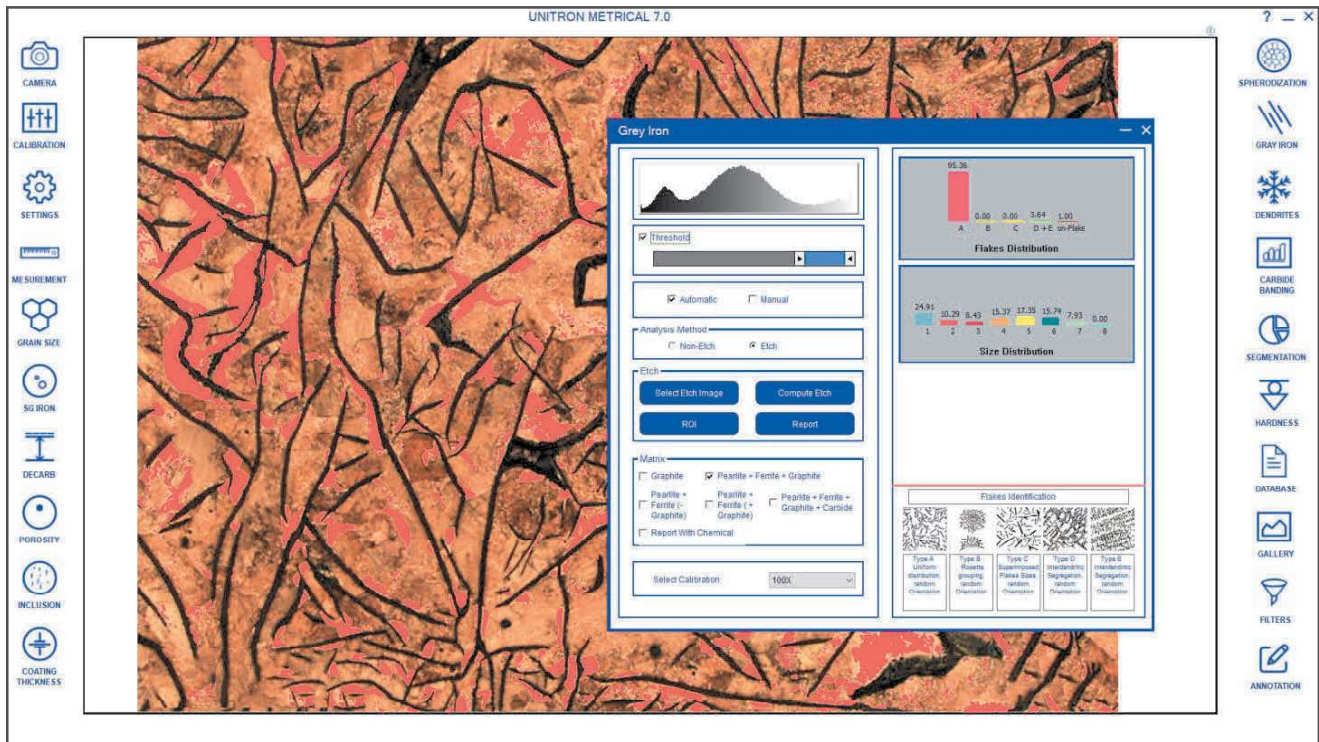


Gray Iron/Graphite Flakes

Gray Iron or Gray Cast Iron is the graphite flakes structure that is created during the cooling process. It is named after the gray color of the fracture its forms, which is due to the presence of graphite. The application measures graphite length in gray iron. The shorter the A type graphite flakes, the highest the strength and better the ductility. The automatic, one button computer program quantitatively analyses the graphite length in Metallography. The graphite sizes are reported in 1-8 classes of size according to ASTM 247-67 or ISO 945 -1 standards. It categorizes graphite flakes from namely type A,B,C,D & E in microstructure sample on the basis of orientation.

The percentage of pearlite is calculated by excluding the graphite area. The matrix of pearlite , Ferrite , graphite are reported in etched sample.

Report is generated wit specific international standards chosen by the user.

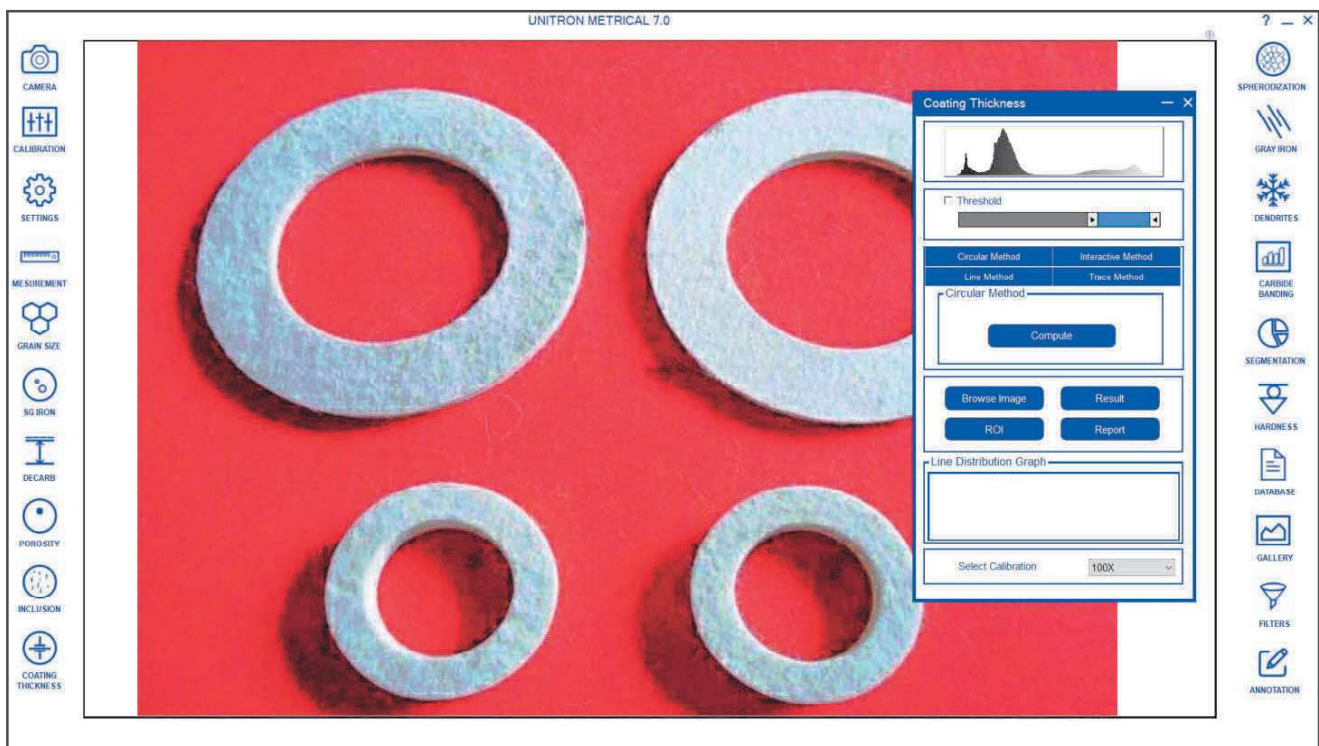

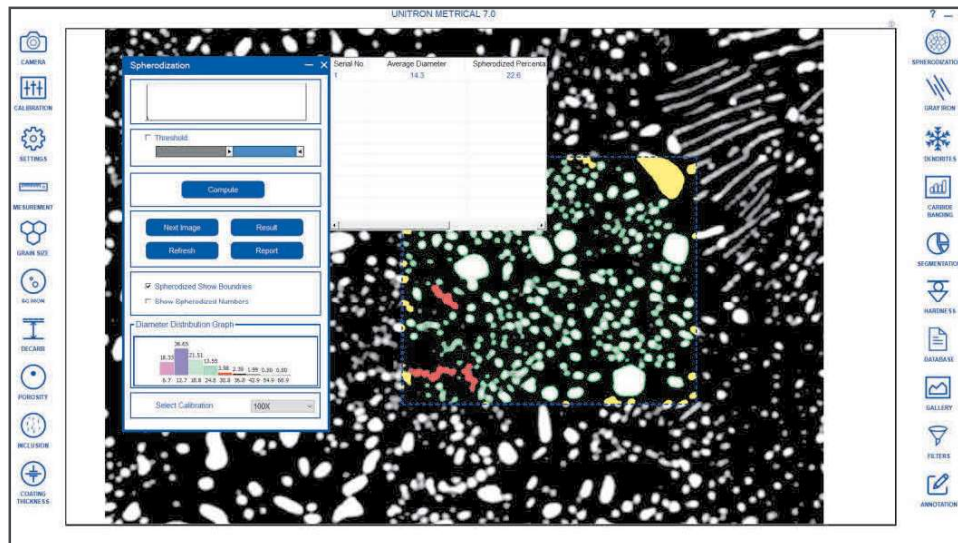
The test method covers measurements of the local thickness of metal and oxide coatings by the microscopical examination of cross sections using an optical microscope. Under good condition, when using an optical microscope, the method is capable of giving an absolute measuring accuracy of 0.8 mm. this with determine the suitability of the method for measuring the thickness of thin coating.

1. Report Type

Options are available to get report either in ASTM or ISO formats. Choose any of them, this will be automatically be in default setting till you modify in future.

2. Set Default Use

Our software give a choice to work either on live display images or you can capture first all images and work on them later.

- It means you want to work on live images. • This is for working on stored / captured images.

3. Select Calibration

Choose calibration which are available in stored data. Usually we do all work on 100X objective in Cast Iron.

4. Set 100 Micron Line

If you need Scale bar on image choose the fourth options available:

- To Show boundary click it if you want to see contour around the graphite.
- Click on Show Number if you want to display counting on graphites.

6. Set Gallery Path

Gallery path is set by default. But if you need to change this path, you can do necessary changes.

7. SG Iron

Various options are available to show different parameters on Nodules. Choose it if you require otherwise contour is created by default.

8. Aspect Ratio

This is usually fixed. But change only if required.

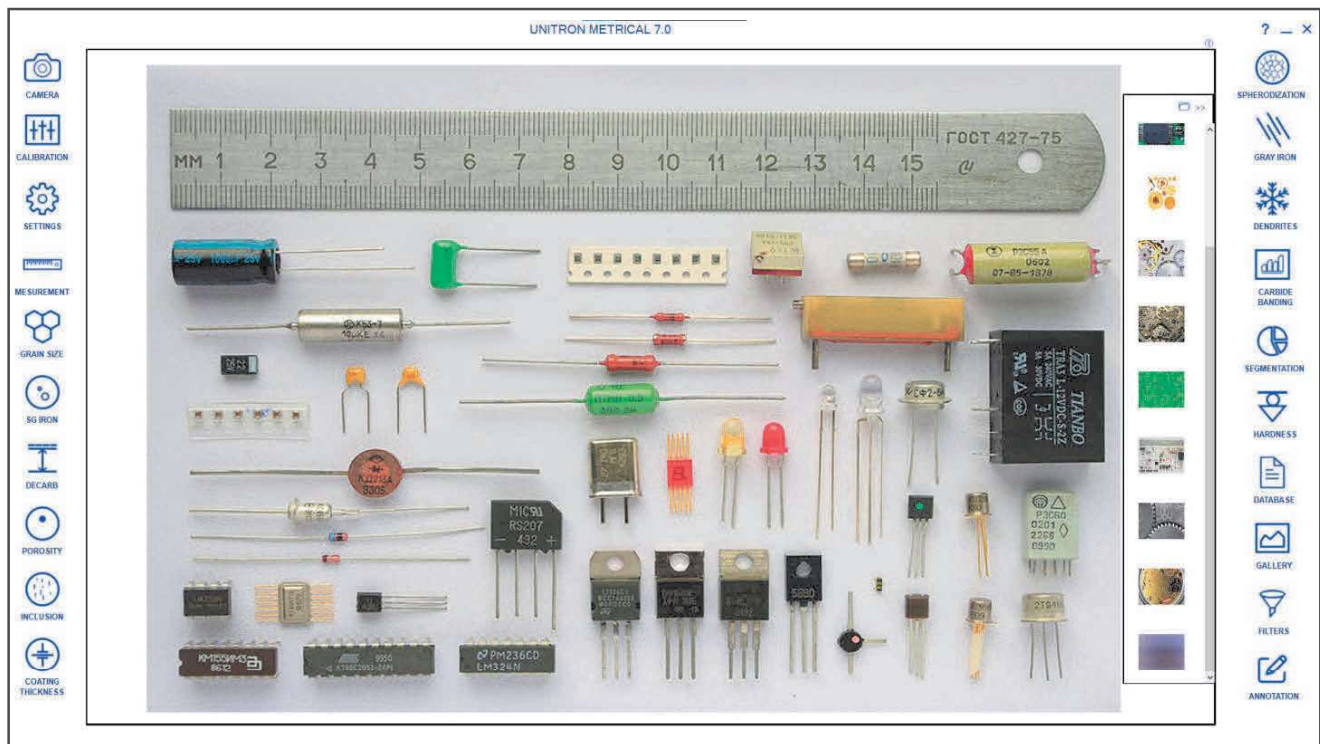

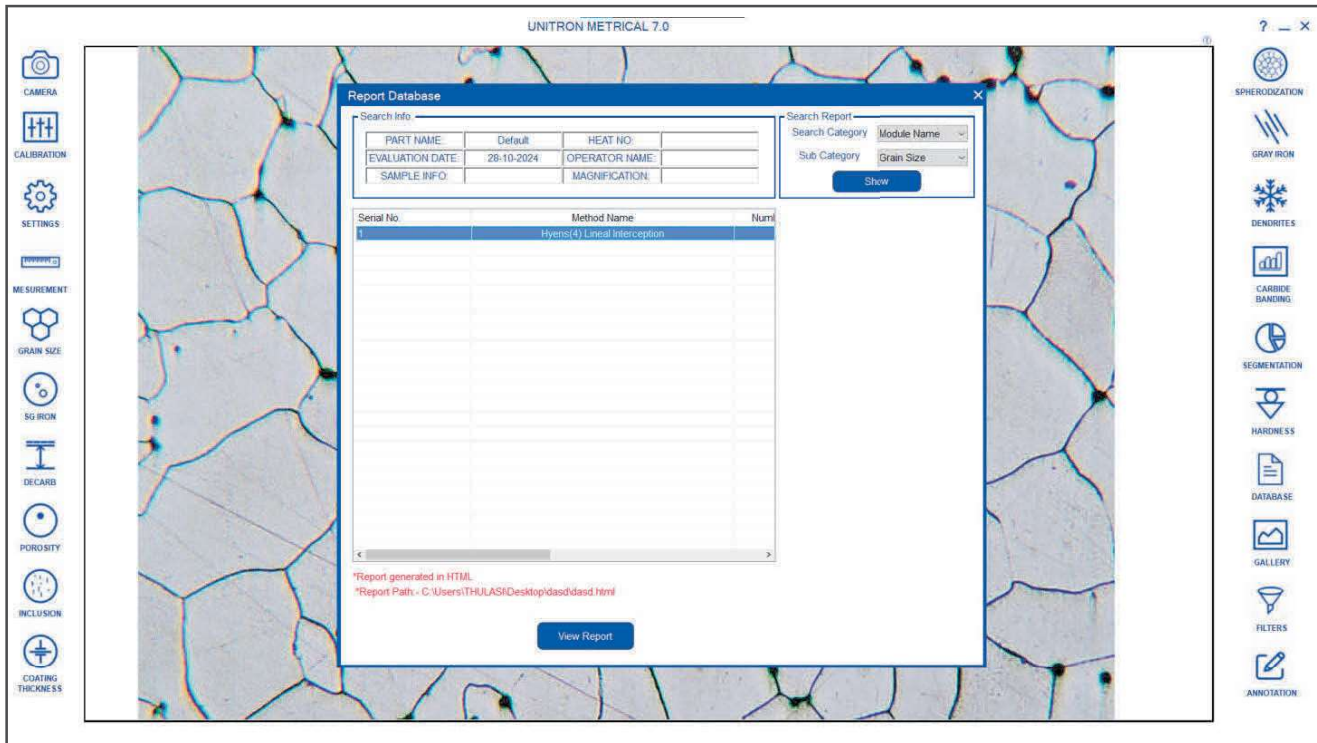
