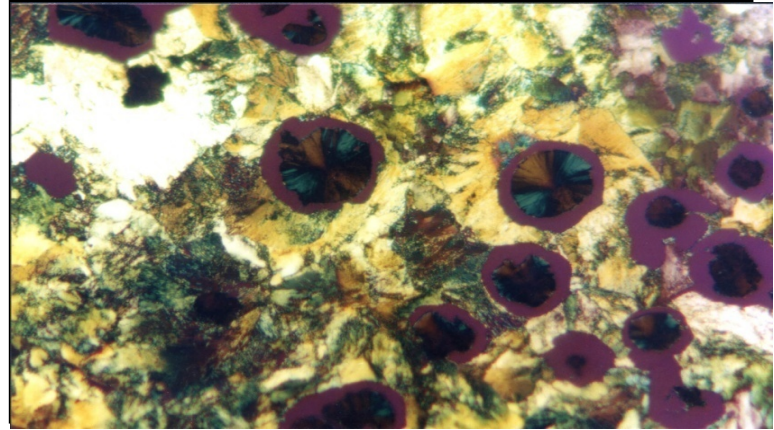


Material : Nodular Cast Iron, Pearlitic

Results

Nodular Cast Iron is a commonly used engineering material. Strength and ductility is very good combined. Matrix is completely pearlitic and ferrite surrounds the graphite nodules.

Magnification: 200X Etching: 2% Nital

Preparation Method:

Cutting: Abrasive Cut-off machine with Metlab RC-50+ Abrasive wheel

Mounting: Mounting Press with Phenolic Powder

Mechanical Preparation: Metpol-A
